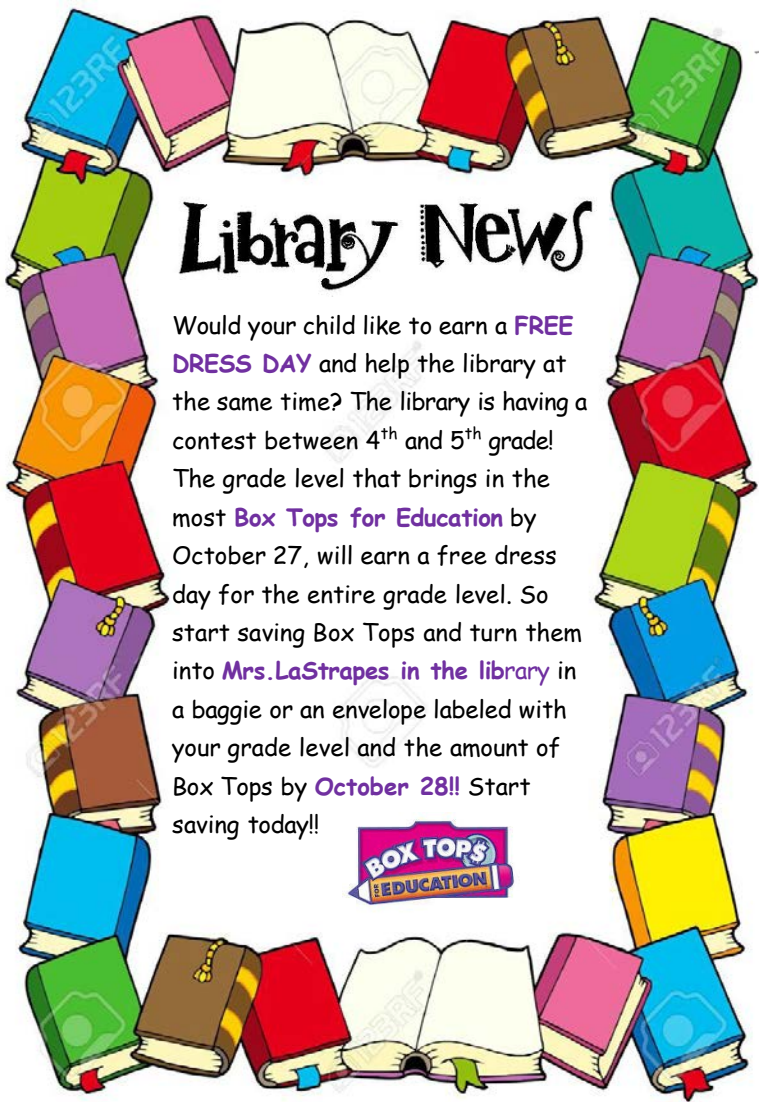
The following will be implemented should a student choose to display negative behavior...

- 1 Mark / week - Verbal Warning
- 2 Marks in a week - Teacher / student conference
- 3 Marks in a week - Practice Academy (or other assigned by administration)
- 4 Marks in a week - Lunch Detention (or other assigned by administration)
- 5 Marks in a week - ISS (or other assigned by administration)



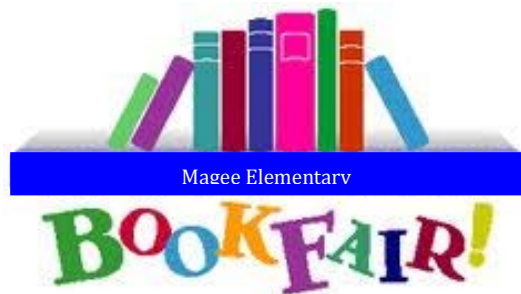
Your child's citizenship grade each class on the report card will be based on the information in the student's planner by each teacher.

- 0 - 1 Marks in the quarter - E (Exemplary)
- 2 - 5 Marks in the quarter - S (Satisfactory)
- 6 - 8 Marks in the quarter - N (Needs Improvement)
- 9 or more Marks in the quarter - U (Unsatisfactory)
