Dear Senior Parents,

Congratulations, you made it! Graduation time is just around the corner and we want to make sure that your child's graduation is a special time for your whole family. Glen Rose ISD strives to make the commencement ceremony a very memorable experience for all students and parents. The feedback we often hear from parents after graduation is the lack of available seating for parents in the lower level of the auditorium. Glen Rose ISD plans to make the lower level available and reserved to all graduates and parents on a ticket basis.

Each graduate will be given four (4) tickets to the lower level reserved section. This will guarantee each senior four seats in the lower section. There are 550 seats in the lower level and 103 graduates. The number of seats in the lower section allows for a maximum of four guests per graduate that can be seated in the lower reserved section.

The remaining 1,447 seats in the auditorium will continue to be on a first come first serve basis. There should be ample seating to accommodate all family members and guests in the auditorium, but the lower section will be reserved seating and each graduate will be allotted four seats in that section.

Please remember the purpose of this implementation is to ensure all parents a number of seats in the lower level section. Each graduate will not be limited to four total guests, but rather four guests in the lower level. Tickets for the reserved section will be mailed two weeks prior to graduation.

Included in this packet is a calendar of events leading up to graduation and information that is important for your graduate. Please pay close attention to times, dates and dress codes so your child will not miss out on any of the memories that go along with this special time.

We will have an informational meeting for senior parents on Thursday May 7th at 6:00 pm in the high school library. The purpose of the meeting will be to explain auditorium seating and information on graduation as well as answering any questions you may have.

Thank you for your support of Glen Rose ISD as we try to make commencement a memorable experience for all.

CLASS OF 2015 PANORAMIC PICTURE AND INDIVIDUAL CAP AND GOWN PICTURES

What is it?

- The Panoramic Picture is a tradition at Glen Rose High School.
- It is a group picture that will remain in the high school and which you may purchase.
- ❖ It's the last professional quality picture of your entire class.
- An individual cap and gown picture will be taken after panoramic of each senior to be displayed on stage screen as you receive your diploma.

Dress Code: It's time for those RED Caps and Gowns!

- Class officers, honor graduates (90 & above GPA), Valedictorian, and Salutatorian must use the following dress code because most of you will be on the front row and what you wear under your gown will show.
 - Girls: dresses or skirts & blouses; dark dress shoes—no white, tennis shoes, or "flip-flop" sandals, please!
 - Guys: dark dress slacks or dark black jeans; white shirts; dark ties; dark dress shoes or nice boots—no sandals or tennis shoes! No facial hair!

<u>ALL Girls</u>: Make sure you have the little white-collar attachment that came with your red gown. If you can attach it before you come to school with needle & thread or small safety pins, it will be much less of a hassle!

ALL Guys: white collared shirts; dark ties (Yellow will not be your color, honestly!)

Shoes don't matter for the rest of you on this day only!

<u>EVERYONE</u>: Caps are to be worn parallel to the ground, not perched on the back of your head. Caps are not to be decorated in any manner.

- Nothing should be attached to or worn on the outside of the robe, including jewelry.
- Graduation caps are not to be decorated in any way.

- Of course, school dress code is applicable.
