Mandatory Language for a Monitoring & Reporting Violation

LEAD AND COPPER MONITORING

Gold-Burg ISD has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality(TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Public Water Systems are required to monitor for Lead and Copper and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ. During January 1 – December 31, 2014, we did not complete all monitoring and/or reporting for lead and copper, and therefore TCEQ cannot be sure of the safety of your drinking water during that time.

We are working to correct the problem. We have put into place a system of automatic notices and scheduling to ensure this does not happen in the future. Gold-Burg ISD apologizes for the inconvenience this notice may cause.

Please share this information with all people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (I.e. people in apartments, nursing homes, schools and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
