Membership responsibilities

- Each member must complete the ISP log sheet and turn it into the advisor by the end of April.
- Graduating Seniors must complete and turn in their logs to the advisor in order to wear the NHS stole during graduation ceremonies.
- You will have 2 opportunities to complete the group project.

 - Feast of Sharing on Christmas Eve
