Objective: Students will create a historical ABC book in which you tell the story of Texas history in a children's format.

TEKS:

7.2A Differentiate between, locate, and use primary and secondary sources such as computer software, databases, media and news services, biographies, interview, and artifacts to acquire information.

Your book should contain the following:

- A decorated cover with a title and your name as the author.
- Each letter of the alphabet on a separate page.
- A word, name, or concept relating to Texas history for each letter of the alphabet
- A thorough definition or explanation or key points for each word, name or concept written in language that a younger child could understand.
- An illustration for each word, name or concept. Illustrations can be drawn, traced, copied, cut from magazines, or done on the computer.
- Be consistent throughout your book. Make it as much like a real ABC book as possible. Your grade will be determined by craftsmanship, creativity, thoroughness, and neatness.
- Remember that spelling, grammar, and handwriting count, too.
