How Parents Can Request Access to Accelerated Reader

1. Go to the following link://https://hosted194renlearn.com/742704/default.aspx
2. Select Parent
3. Click on Request Parent/Guardian access on the parent login page
4. The request page will open

- Type your first and last name in the blank fields
- Enter an email address so that the school or district can use it to send info if necessary
- Identify all of your children who may be using Accelerated Reader
- Use the Number of Children drop-down list to choose the correct number of children.
- Type the first and last name for each child in the appropriate blank fields.
- For each child you must also use the Parent/Guardian Relationship drop-down list to choose your relationship to the child.

5. When you finish filling out the form, and you're ready to send it to the school district, click Sve to send the form.
6. The next page will show you the information you've entered. Click Done
7. The District Administrator will then view your request and grant access.
