Dear Winston School Family and Friends,

The Winston School is blessed with a dedicated Board and an extended group of families, alumni and community members who understand and believe in our mission. All of your contributions are essential to our mission; a mission that teaches *bright students who learn differently*®. Most parents are surprised to find that tuition does not cover the cost of their child's education. At The Winston School tuition and fees cover approximately 85% of the cost of the education, as is the case with many other independent schools. Our development efforts are designed, in part, to solicit charitable gifts to bridge the gap between tuition income and the actual cost of operating the School. Gifts to the Annual Fund are used to pay the annual operating expenses of our School. Teacher recruitment and training, curriculum and program enhancements, support for our creative and performing arts, athletic programs, technology upgrades and maintenance of existing facilities are examples of ways in which these gifts are used.

Within our community you will find evidence of not only students who have **charted the course to the future**, but teachers who have been there encouraging their growth through efforts that are further supported through the tremendous hours of commitment to our students and their families.

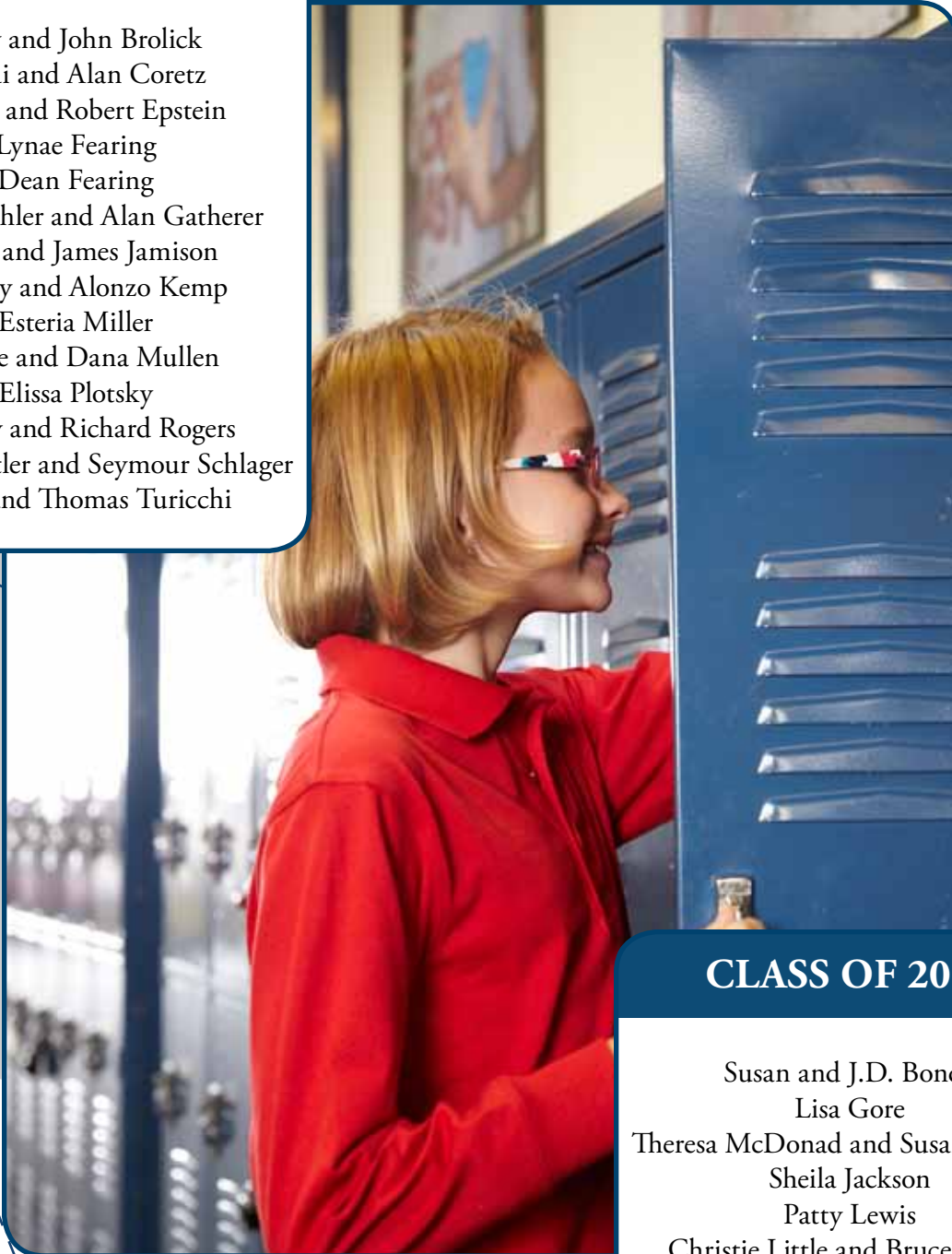

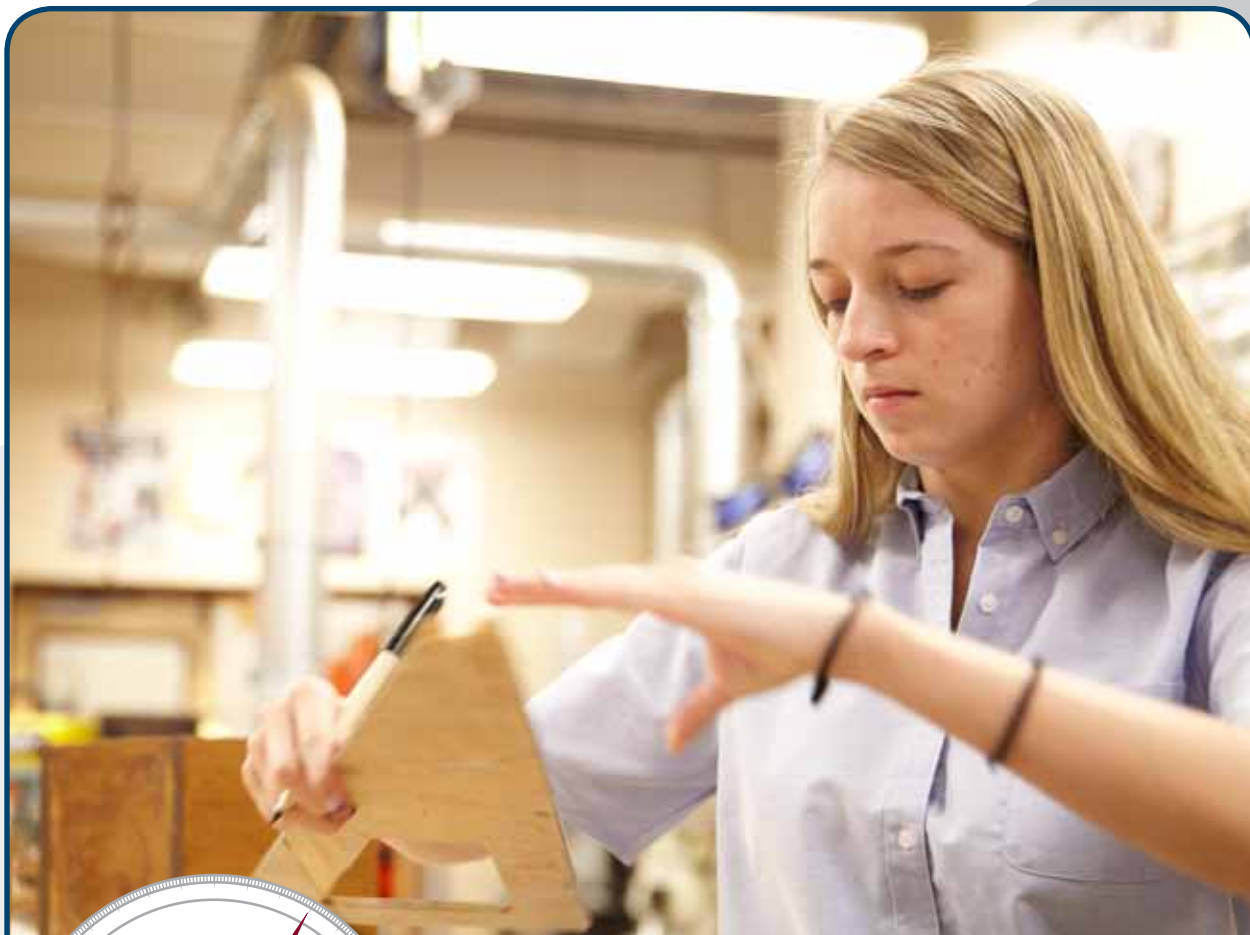

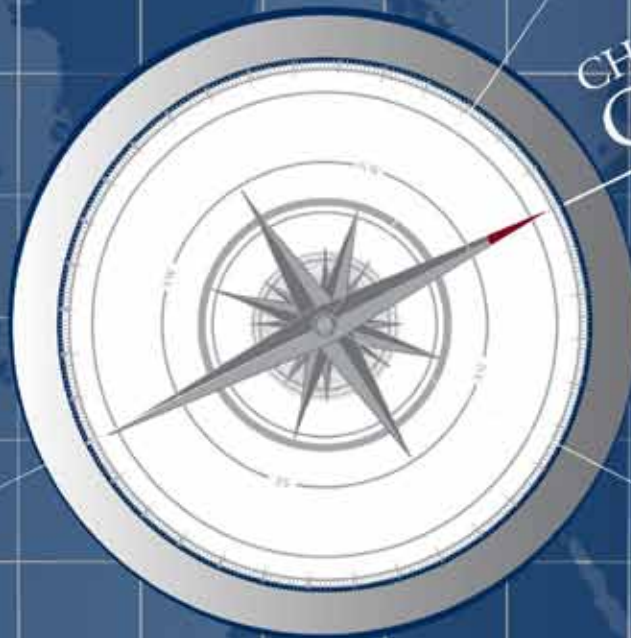
