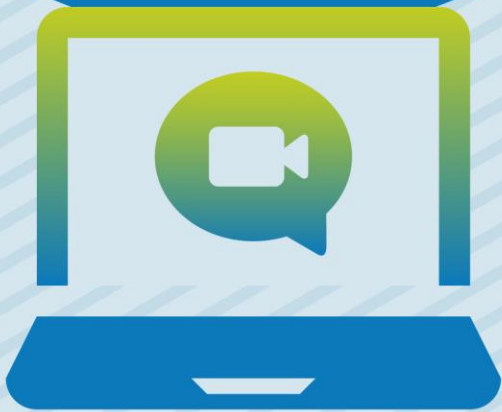

The goal of Cyber Girls is to show middle school girls the importance of inclusion of security principles in all areas of computer science. Participants will learn secure coding, network administration, database safety, secure website design, and information security.

This program will get girls in grades 6-8 excited about technology and have some fun using it. The participants will progress through cyber security concepts, computer science concepts, command robots, line robots, drag and drop programming, visual programming, blocking coding, object-oriented programming, website design, app development, ciphers, and digital forensics. While learning to be a producer of technology, they will learn about careers in technology and throughout STEM. The camp is packed with fun and engaging activities and will be taught by a local female high school students in coordination with female college faculty.
