## CAMP

Rapp Nature Camp has been providing an immersive nature-study day-camp for younger children for over 30 years. This year we are very excited to be able to offer camp to 12-16 year old teens (Session 2) and we still have spaces available.

Session 2 will allow older campers to connect their earlier camp experiences with new, in-depth natural history studies, and to consider their own connections with the lives of younger campers to follow in future years. We'll study the quality of the clear water in the Hazel River, and learn about caring for trees and habitats and oceans and the air we live in. Several visiting instructors will provide lessons in mycology, falconry, stream studies, nature art, and many surprises.

Activities are almost all outdoors and will include games and songs, hiking, identifying butterflies and moths, learning to recognize all kinds of snakes, assessing water quality, catching and releasing wild animals, caring for flowers and trees and producing a camp newspaper. Note that all campers will be expected to participate in all activities, including writing, drawing and oral presentations. Be prepared to get wet and muddy! Camp days are Monday - Friday, 9AM - 3PM

## TUITION AND REGISTRATION

Tuition for two weeks is \$325 (Session 2). Please do not hesitate to let us know if you need financial assistance - we very much want to see you at camp and will make every effort to accommodate.

## STAFF

Lyt Wood, local arborist and one of the camp's founding directors, will again direct the Rapp Nature Camp. He is experienced as an outdoor educator and has hosted the camp at his property since 1996. Kat Habib artist, as well as college and career guide, will serve as assistant director. We will also have several experienced counselors and counselors-in-training.
