Eligibility Requirements

Applicants **MUST**:

- be enrolled in an accredited Wisconsin high school.
- be a resident of Wisconsin.
- have completed the first half of the 12th grade.
- have a grade transcript showing the results of at least one college entrance exam (ACT, SAT, PSAT).
- in September, 2011, enter a bachelor's degree program in the curriculum of Medical Technology/Clinical Laboratory Science at an accredited college or university in the State of Wisconsin. (Please refer to the list of accredited colleges and universities on the next page.)

Please note that students who plan on attending a 2 year UW Center for their initial course work before transferring to one of the listed UW campuses are also eligible, provided their undergraduate application or admission indicates that their intended major is MT/CLS.

Scholarship Criteria

Applicants will be judged and awards given on the basis of scholastic accomplishments, extra-curricular activities, written communication skills and character.

Award Payment

Awards will be paid to the appropriate college or university Bursar on behalf of the recipient at the rate of \$500/semester for 4 years. Recipient must maintain satisfactory grades and remain in the MT/CLS program as a condition of continuing payments.
