ME1. We will use STAR Diagnostic to measure student ability levels every nine weeks and group them into Support for Personalized Learning (SPL) classes. We will have SPL Math on Wednesday's. We will also use math benchmarking scores as well as pre-tests and post-tests from teacher goals. We will be using Formative Assessment to give students immediate feedback which will be measured through E-Walks and Lesson Plans. Our final evidence will come from the Smarter Balanced assessment at the end of the 2016-2017 school year.

Goal2. By the end of the 2016-2017 fiscal year, English Language Arts scores will increase by 11.58% to meet the target score as measured by the Smarter Balanced assessment. ME2. We will use STAR Diagnostic to measure student ability levels every nine weeks and group them into Support for Personalized Learning (SPL) classes. We will have SPL English Language Arts on Mondays and Fridays. We will also be looking at student Lexile levels in the Achieve 3000 program and monitoring their progress through weekly reports sent to our staff from Achieve 3000. We will be using Formative Assessment to give students immediate feedback which will be measured through E-Walks and Lesson Plans. Within the English Language Arts PLC, strategies will be discussed and students needing intensive support will be identified.
