COMPUTER SYSTEMS RECEIVED GRANT

Congratulations to Rebecca Keathley's Computer Systems Repair Program for receiving a 2018 Modernization Grant from the West Virginia Department of Career and Technical Education . This \$20,000 Modernization Grant will enable her program to received new and innovative equipment and supplies to keep her program on the cutting edge and train her students on the technology that business and industry are seeking in employees. The Modernization Grant is very competitive and only awarded to a small percentage of programs within the state. The grants can only be written by the students within the program and must be submitted on behalf of the teacher.

Written into the grant was a RAM tester, diagnostics tools and computer parts for the construction of computers for use in her lab. Students will be able to build from the ground up a new state of the art computer that will allow students to use their skills and expertise to highlight learning within the Computer Systems Repair Program. A state of the art 3D printer was also included in the grant that will be used to make computer parts for replacement in computers her classroom repairs. The last thing included in this grant was a test out program to allow her students additional resources to gain skills required for the NOCTI end of the year testing for all senior completers.
