

CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION IN LOGAN COUNTY

EARLY COLLEGE ACADEMY

Logan County Schools and Southern West Virginia Community and Technical College have officially announced their joint efforts to offer college courses to high school students on the Logan campus.

The program will offer college English 101 and Math 121 courses for high school students during the 2019 Spring semester. Juniors and seniors are eligible to participate. For \$50 (\$25 per class), students can earn six college credit hours before even graduating high school. Assistance is offered to students in need.

The **Early College Academy** courses will be taught on the Logan Campus of SWVCTC. Students will be provided bus transportation to and from the college for classes. Students will not be allowed to drive to the campus.

Students who are interested in learning more about the Academy must attend a parent/student information session. There will be three sessions: Chapmanville Regional High School on Wednesday, Oct. 24, at Man High School on Monday, Oct 29, and Logan High school on Monday, Nov.5. All sessions will begin at 6 p.m.

Classes will begin Jan. 14, 2019, and students can contact their school's principal for more information. There are a limited number of spots available.

We would love to see our CTE students both juniors and seniors apply for these courses. Remember you are already eligible for up to 28 EDGE (Earn a Degree Graduate Early) college credits at no cost if you meet the criteria of eligibility.
