ADULT SEX OFFENDERS

3.41

1. Adult sex offenders who have been convicted of a sex offense involving a minor must:
 1. Notify the principal of the school or his designee before entering school property or attending a school activity;
 1. Immediately report to the principal of the school or his designee upon entering the property or arriving at a school activity; and
 1. Cooperate with any efforts undertaken by the principal of the school or his designee to discreetly monitor their presence on school property or at a school activity.
1. For the purposes of this subsection, a school activity is an activity sponsored by a school in which students are the primary intended participants or for whom students are the primary intended audience including, but not limited to, school instructional time, after school care, after school tutoring, athletic events, field trips, school plays, or assemblies.
2. Adult sex offenders have a duty to comply with this policy, and it shall not be construed to impose an affirmative duty of any kind on the school principal, his designee, or any other employee, agent, or representative of the school or school system.
