## 3.42

### ALCOHOL, ILLEGAL DRUGS AT SYSTEM ACTIVITIES

3.42

No person shall be in possession of or be under the influence of an intoxicating beverage or an illegal drug, as defined by Alabama law, while on Alexander City School System property, at school-sponsored activities, or while on school trips involving students.

1. Principals must notify local law enforcement when this policy has been violated.
1. Persons in violation of this policy are subject to disciplinary actions as described in the Code of Conduct, personnel/employment policies, and legal prosecution.
1. Any other person having purchased an admission ticket to a Alexander City School System event shall forfeit his/her rights under this rule by having an alcoholic beverage/illegal drugs in his/her possession at the event or be under the influence of an intoxicating beverage or illegal drug.
