CHILD NUTRITION PROGRAM

8.40

1. The Alexander City Board of Education shall provide nutritious and adequate meals to all students at a minimal cost. The Child Nutrition Program Director, in conjunction with the school principal, is responsible for ensuring the Child Nutrition Program is operated in compliance with federal, state and local laws and regulations as well as policies of the Board.

1. It is an objective of the Alexander City School System that all students have the opportunity to participate in the school lunch program. The Child Nutrition Program Director shall determine, in accordance with federal regulations, those students eligible for free or reduced price lunches.
 - The Alexander City Board of Education Child Nutrition Program (CNP) lunchrooms shall incorporate food safety practices as outlined under Hazard and Critical Control Point (HACCP) guidelines, Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) shall be developed for handling, storage, preparation, and serving of all foods.

1. The Superintendent is instructed to develop all policies and procedures in compliance with state regulations.
