Parental Involvement In Title I Program

Date Adopted: November 26, 2002 **Date Revised**

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The Board of Education will involve parents in the Title I Program in the following manner:

- Parental involvement in the Title I Program will be an integral part of the Board of Education's services.
- Parents of Title I students will be surveyed annually to discern their opinions and suggestions concerning the program.
- A public advertised meeting will be held annually in order to obtain parental suggestions and considerations in the planning of the program services.
- Parents of Title I students will be scheduled for parent conferences with the Title I Instructors at the same time as the total school's conferences.
- Efforts will be made to involve parents in the instructional process by the instructional staff through consultation and assistance with teacher-directed homework.
- Records will be maintained on all Title I parent involvement activities for statistical and subjective consideration of the success of efforts.
