This notice is to inform you of Alvarado Independent School District's status regarding the employment of teachers who are considered "highly qualified" according to the federal No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act of 2001. The No Child Left Behind Act requires teachers of core academic subjects to be highly qualified by the end of the 2005-2006 school year. The act further requires that teachers receive high-quality professional development.
