

ALVORD MIDDLE SCHOOL BAND POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

The Alvord Middle School Band includes students in grades 6-8. All students who are members of the band must participate in all middle school band activities. Students are also required to participate in solo and ensemble contest, and may be assigned to participate in all-region auditions or other activities. All school-wide attendance, tardy and behavior policies will be strictly enforced.

Students may not bring food, drinks or gum into the band hall. Cell phone use must comply with school policy and is always at the band director's discretion. All instruments should be cleaned and returned to cases following every class period. Cases should be fully closed and latched. Students will be assigned a storage cubby and should keep their assigned cubby neat and organized.

Students are encouraged to take their instruments home every day to practice.

GRADING POLICY

Band grading is based upon attendance and participation at all rehearsals and performances, as well as completion of Practice Log Assignments. During some 6-weeks periods, grading may be based on an "objective sheet", listing certain criteria which students must perform during the grading period. Each objective will be graded on a pass/fail basis. Students will receive a grade for each rehearsal and performance, except those which occur during the regular school day.

Students may be assigned lower grades for the following reasons:

Failure to arrive, on time, with all required materials

Behavior which is disruptive to the rehearsal

Failure to Participate Fully

Failure to arrive, on time, in the proper attire to any performance

Failure to fully prepare and/or passoff music by required deadlines

Incomplete Practice Logs or Objective Sheets

SCHOOL INSTRUMENTS

Alvord ISD provides school musical instruments for the low woodwind, low brass and percussion sections. These instruments are quite costly and are not normally owned by individuals. All of these instruments are sent to the repair shop and reconditioned during the summer.

Percussionists will be required to purchase their own sticks and stick bag.

Brass players who are using a school-owned instrument will need to own their own mouthpiece.

All other students will be expected to purchase or rent an instrument through a local music store. If the cost is an issue, the Alvord Band may be able to provide financial assistance.

A complete list of recommended instruments is included in this document. Instruments other than the ones listed will need to be approved by the band directors.

Any damage or normal adjustment during the year is the responsibility of the band student who has signed for the instrument.

We expect the instrument to be returned in the same condition as when issued. Dings, dents, and other damage will be repaired at the student's expense.

If the instrument is lost or stolen while checked out to a student, it is the **parent's/guardian's responsibility** to replace the instrument.

USE OF BAND HALL FACILITIES

ONLY band students are allowed in the band hall. Students must ask their friends who are not in band to wait for them either in the school hallway or outside.

REPAIRS

Instrument repairs may be needed during the semester. Students and parents are encouraged to take their instruments to the repair shop. If this is not possible, a representative from Tarpley music travels to the school each week to pick up and drop off repairs. Students will be charged for any repairs to student-owned instruments and to school-owned instruments not deemed not to be from regular wear and tear. DO NOT, under any circumstances, attempt to repair your own instrument!

SUPPLIES

It is imperative that band students be **prepared** for every rehearsal. All students are expected to have the following supplies at every rehearsal:

Instrument

Accessories (Reeds, Sticks, Mouthpiece, Valve Oil, etc.)

Pencil

Band Binder with Page Protectors

Standard of Excellence Book 1 for your Instrument

Foundations for Superior Performance book for your Instrument

Tuner with Clip-On Attachment and Metronome

BINDERS

Band binders are a required material for this course. A binder will be provided to any student who does not have one. All music must be placed in page protectors and be readily accessible. Students must have their binder and all required books every day. Each student will have their own music and music stand. You **MAY NOT** share music. See the required materials list to determine which books will be required.

ATTIRE

All Alvord Middle School Band Students must own at least one Alvord Band "A" T-Shirt. This shirt will be worn at all band concerts and contests. Shirts will be ordered in September. The shirt order form is located at the end of this document and on the band website.

Students may also choose to order an Alvord Band "A" Hoodie. At the discretion of the directors, students may wear this over the "A" shirt at certain events.

PRIVATE LESSONS

Students in all grade levels will be offered the opportunity to take private lessons from qualified music instructors. Private lessons provide one-on-one focused instruction and are the best way to improve quickly. These lessons are available for \$15.00 per 30 minutes and will be taught at the high school band hall. If you are interested in private lessons but require financial assistance, scholarships may be available through the band booster program. Please indicate the need for financial assistance on the enrollment form.

After initial private lesson enrollment, students and parents will be expected to satisfy all financial obligations to their lesson teacher in a timely manner. Students will also be expected to communicate any scheduling conflicts or cancellations to their lesson teacher in accordance with the policies set forth by the teacher. Lesson schedules and cancellations will not be communicated by the band directors.

If you are interested in enrolling in private lessons, further information and an enrollment form can be found at the end of this document.

OFF-CAMPUS TRAVEL POLICIES

Students who represent Alvord ISD on off-campus trips are expected to maintain very high standards of conduct at all times. They are expected to attend and be on time for all sessions and activities scheduled for them. In the event of overnight trips, they are expected to be in their rooms at the times designated by their sponsors.

Each student will be responsible to one or more faculty sponsors who will supervise the activities of the student for the trip. Negligence in attending sessions, in meeting curfew requirements, or in failing to maintain our standards of conduct may make it necessary for the sponsor to send the student home at his/her own expense.

Student conduct on school-related trips: Self-discipline is the key element for a pleasant experience for both the sponsor and the student when the student is on a school-related trip. Students who are involved in a serious disciplinary offense on a school-related trip, such as the use, possession of, or being under the influence of illegal drugs or alcohol, stealing, fighting, going in the room of a member of the opposite sex, or some other serious offense will face disciplinary action which may include one or more of the following:

- 1. The student will be sent home from the trip at the parents' expense.
- 2. The student will be held liable for damages to property.
- 3. The student may be removed from this school activity as well as other school co-curricular activities.
- 4. The student may be placed in In-School-Suspension (ISS), Off-Campus-Suspension, or Alternative Education Placement.

Students' attire during school activities outside the school day should be in good taste. If there is any question of taste, the director's decision is final.
