Principals Roberto Baeza, Benito Juarez School, and Suzy McMasters, Adelaide Price School, DLI staff, parents and students provided an overview of the DLI program. Established at Price in 2006 with 26 first-grade students, the current enrollment includes 351 students in grades K-6 at two school sites. The program's goals are to develop language proficiency in English and Spanish for native English speakers and native Spanish speakers, to ensure academic excellence as outlined in the School District's core curriculum by increasing scholastic achievement in two languages, to cultivate an understanding and appreciation of diverse cultures, and to empower parents to become active participants in their children's education.
