

**CHAPTER 2.00 - SCHOOL BOARD GOVERNANCE AND ORGANIZATION**

**SPECIAL COMMITTEES OF THE SCHOOL BOARD**

**2.26**

- I. Special committees may be appointed by the Barbour County Board of Education President when deemed necessary. The duties of any such committee shall be outlined at the time of appointment; the committee shall be automatically dissolved when the Barbour County Board of Education accepts the committee's final report. Each Barbour County Board of Education member shall be notified of all committee meetings, but shall have no vote unless the member is serving as a committee member. All meetings of Barbour County Board of Education committees shall be open to the public.
  
- II. Special committees or individuals who serve on special committees shall take no action which is binding upon the Barbour County Board of Education.
