Being honored this year are the late Second Lieutenant David Stephen Deters and the late Sergeant Louis Andrew Niemeyer, Jr. David was a 1963 graduate of BGHS and Louis was a 1965 graduate. Louis was killed in action on September 24, 1968. He was a member of C CO, 3rd BN, 8th Infantry, 4th INF DIV, USARV, Army of the United States. David was killed in action on August 12, 1969. He was a member of HOWITZER BTRY, 1ST SQDN, 11TH Armored Calvary, USARV, Army of the United States. Both men are buried in the St. Clement Cemetery.
