NTI Days in the Breckinridge County School District

Recent winter weather has caused the Breckinridge County School District to miss some school and begin utilizing state approved Non-traditional Instruction (NTI) days. The Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) approved our district's participation in this program last summer. As a result, we are allowed to use up to ten NTI days throughout the 2018-19 school year. Staff members in the school district have worked to develop engaging assignments for our students to complete on missed days of school designated as an "NTI Day." Students completing this work on NTI Days will allow our school district to count those missed days as an attendance day in the school year. Helping students and their parents/guardians on NTI Days is something that we take very seriously in the school district.
