Open Registration for 2019-2020 Preschool and Kindergarten Students

Child **MUST** turn 3 years of age on or before October 1, 2019 for Preschool **OR** turn 5 years of age on or before October 1, 2019 for Kindergarten. **Note:** It is not necessary for you to bring your child to register.

***If your child is already attending our Preschool you DO NOT have to register.**

Registration will be held at the North Middle School Admissions Office at the following days/times:

March 18, 2019	5:00 – 7:30 PM
March 19, 2019	5:00 – 7:30 PM
March 20, 2019	8:00 – 11:00 AM & 12:30 – 2:30 PM
March 21, 2019	8:00 – 11:00 AM & 12:30 – 2:30 PM

The following documents are **REQUIRED** for registration:

1. Child's Original Birth Certificate (Must be State copy - NOT Hospital copy)
2. Child's Current Immunization Records
3. Proof of Residency

PROOF OF RESIDENCY REQUESTED ITEMS

HOMEOWNER: Deed or most recent tax bill from the City of Brigantine

RENTERS: A Lease or notarized letter from the landlord listing ALL occupants, or other evidence of residency and any 2 items from the following list:

- Paystub with name and address
- Utility bills - Gas, Electric or Home Phone Only
- Voter Registration Card
- Financial account information containing home address
- Other documentation will be considered

RESIDENTS SHARING QUARTERS: (PLEASE PROVIDE ALL ITEMS)

1. Owner's deed or most recent tax bill from the City of Brigantine
2. Notarized letter from the owner listing ALL occupants
3. Proof of address for the parent (Paycheck Stub, Utility Bill, etc.)

(ALL THREE DOCUMENTS ARE NEEDED FOR SHARED QUARTERS)

REGISTRATION WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED COMPLETE WITHOUT ALL NECESSARY PAPERWORK.
