Open Registration for 2017-2018 Preschool and Kindergarten Students

Child **MUST** turn 4 years of age on or before October 1, 2017 for Preschool **OR** turn 5 years of age on or before October 1, 2017 for Kindergarten.

Registration is in the North Middle School Admissions Office, Monday through Friday - 9:00 AM-11:00 AM and 1:00 PM-3:00 PM. No screenings will take place at this time, therefore, it is not necessary for you to bring your child. **Please call 609.266.8591 for an appointment.**

The following documents are REQUIRED for registration:

1. Child's Original Birth Certificate (Must be State copy - NOT Hospital copy)
2. Child's Immunization Records **
3. Proof of Residency

All children enrolling in September must have 4 DPT and 3 Polio immunizations. The last one must have been administered on or after the child's fourth birthday. Additional immunizations include one dose or written documentation of chicken pox disease and at least 1 MMR, a second dose of measles vaccine, and a complete Hepatitis B series **BEFORE** they can be admitted to school.

PROOF OF RESIDENCY REQUESTED ITEMS

HOMEOWNER: Deed or most recent tax bill from the City of Brigantine

RENTERS: A Lease or notarized letter from the landlord listing **ALL** occupants, or other evidence of residency and any 2 items from the following list:

- Paystub with name and address
- Utility bills - Gas, Electric or Home Phone Only
- Voter Registration Card
- Financial account information containing home address
- Other documentation will be considered.

RESIDENTS SHARING QUARTERS: (PLEASE PROVIDE ALL ITEMS)

1. Owner's deed or most recent tax bill from the City of Brigantine
2. Notarized letter from the owner listing **ALL** occupants
3. Proof of address for the parent (Paycheck Stub, Utility Bill, etc.)

(ALL THREE DOCUMENTS ARE NEEDED FOR SHARED QUARTERS)

***Other documents you may want to bring with you are:** Physician's/Doctor's address and phone number; Emergency Contact information such as addresses and phone numbers.

YOUR CHILD'S REGISTRATION WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED COMPLETE WITHOUT ALL NECESSARY PAPERWORK.
