Dear Parents/Guardians and Students:

The Brigantine Public School District is committed to encouraging students to explore their interests and abilities beyond the traditional academic classroom. As part of this commitment, eighth grade students are afforded the opportunity to have choices when selecting some of their special area classes for the 2018-2019 school year. Included is a specials selection sheet as well as descriptions of the courses we offer. Please review the information enclosed and help your student select their courses for this year.

- During one of your child's two specials periods, he or she will have Gym or Health four days a week and Spanish on the fifth day. This will fulfill state requirements for Physical Education as well as allow students to take Spanish throughout their eighth grade year in preparation for high school.
- During your child's other specials period, each student will take 4 different classes-one during each marking period. Each class will meet five days a week for one marking period.
- Students that take instrumental music lessons will be assigned to a lesson one day a week depending on their instrument in addition to their specials selections.
- We will do our best to ensure students get their top choices but please understand we may have to move classes around to balance the class sizes. Please make sure your child lists their classes in order of importance to them.
