By completing this application, you are agreeing to the terms and conditions of the Study Abroad Package, which includes a range of impressive benefits, wrapped up in one inclusive fee, so you do not have to worry about anything – we arrange the tuition, arrival, accommodation, catering and orientation for you.

You also agree to the terms and conditions of the Accommodation Contract and the payment of the Accommodation Deposit (if applicable), which is refunded after you leave (conditions apply). A copy of the Contract will be sent to you with your room details.

Your room will be a single room in a shared apartment with a communal kitchen, located at our residential campus, Aigburth Park, where you will find an impressive range of communal facilities, such as a large common room, vending area, laundry room, access to free computers and printing facilities and pleasant gardens.

The **course selection form** should be discussed and completed with your Study Abroad Advisor and sent to internationalhub@hope.ac.uk by 1 July 2018.

The Study Abroad Package

 or store at Hope Park or the Creative Campus

- ✓ an Orientation Program and the support of the International Hub
- ✓ 24 hour Security and evening and weekend Residential Life staff
- ✓ On-site Launderette
- ✓ free shuttle buses to and from the teaching campuses
- ✓ unrestricted use of the Library and IT facilities at the teaching campuses
- ✓ free and unlimited WiFi in your study room and all areas of the University (restricted for on-line gaming)
