0401100 Islamic Culture, 3 credit hours (Islamic culture compared to other world cultures, its way of solutions to problems, the challenges facing Islamic culture, and the future of Islamic culture)

0401404 Islamic Studies, 3 credit hours (Islamic religious vocabulary and discussions on selected texts from the Qur'an, Hadith books, and ancient and contemporary Islamic books)

Survey Trip (Sites selected by CGE Jordan director. Previous trips: Israel, Palestine, Egypt)

Mid-term Survey (trip is not for academic credit unless student's home institution proposes, with the student, a credit bearing option)
