#### Section 1: Home University & Proposed Length of Study

Home University	Please enter the full name of the institution where you are currently studying.
Proposed length of study	Please tick to indicate if you are to study for the full academic year, or one semester (First Semester is September start / Second Semester is January start.

#### **Section 2a: Personal Details**

Name	Your names should exactly as they appear in your passport, to ensure that any future correspondence we send you matches your passport.
Date of Birth	In format DD/MM/YYYY
Contact details	If we have to contact you to discuss your application, we will use your email address in the first instance and your telephone numbers if we do not receive a response, or if the matter is urgent.
Passport Number	As shown on your passport

As all tuition is in English, you must possess a suitable English Language qualification or provide other evidence that you satisfy the English Language proficiency requirement and will therefore be able to pursue the proposed course of study.

If you are awaiting examinations, please send your results as soon as they are available. All English Language qualifications will be verified with the relevant awarding body. Please submit certified copies of your English Language qualification. Do not send original transcripts or certificates.

Liverpool Hope University accepts a range of English Language qualifications, including:

GCSE English Language at Grade C or above conducted by a UK examination board; IELTS - at score 6.0 including reading score 6.0 and writing score 6.0. If you possess a degree or an approved equivalent qualification from an institution for which teaching and assessment was conducted in English, please state this in Section 4, as this may satisfy the English Language proficiency requirement.
