Commitment to Donors

Information submitted through online payments is processed through Authorize.Net who is PCI compliant. PCI compliance guides the processing and storage of names, service payments, contribution amounts, addresses, phone numbers per secure channels and website guidelines through Authorize.Net.

Notice: Information Collected
