## Notable Honors or Rankings

U.S. News & World Report ranks CBU as one of the western region's top universities, #15 in best online bachelor's programs and #13 on the list of best programs for veterans; listed among Colleges of Distinction and a Military-Friendly School by G.I. Jobs. CBU's Lancer Athletics won three Pacific West championships in 2014, resulting in the 2014 PacWest Commissioner's Cup, awarded to the top overall athletic program in the conference. In its first year as a full member of NCAA Division II, the Lancers competed in postseason tournaments in basketball, softball and swim & dive, with swimmer Mary Hanson winning the DII championship. In addition, CBU's cheer team won two national championships: the National Cheerleading Association Championship for the second year in a row and the USA College Career Championship for the third straight year.
