TRANSPORTATION

1. Transportation for students with disabilities shall be provided in accordance with established state and federal laws and procedures. For specific information regarding transportation, please refer to Pupil Transportation and Georgia School Bus Specifications provided by the Georgia Department of Education.
2. Vehicles used to transport students with disabilities shall be modified appropriately according to the specific needs of the students. This may include such equipment as power lifts, wheelchair fasteners, special seat belts, harnesses, car seats and two-way radios.
3. Provision shall be made for adequate supervision of all students with disabilities while they are being transported. This may entail the use of support personnel if the physical, behavioral, intellectual or developmental status of the students indicates a need for more supervision.
4. When, because of a student's disability, the IEP/Placement Committee determines that special transportation is required, such transportation needs shall be specified in the student's IEP, and the local school system shall ensure that such services are provided.
