Trespassing on School Grounds

The North Carolina Trespass Laws shall be enforced relative to property of the Caswell County Schools. All visitors are required to proceed and report first to the school Principal's office upon visiting the school. These visitors may include parents/legal guardians/legal custodians of pupils, interested citizens, invited speakers, Central office staff personnel, maintenance and repair people, salesmen, representatives of the news media, students not currently enrolled in school, and others. Signs shall be posted at each school entrance to indicate this requirement.

Unauthorized Use of School Property

Property owned by the Caswell County Board of Education may not be used for private purposes except as allowed by Board Policy #820, Use of School Facilities.

Recreational conveyances are prohibited on Caswell County Schools' property.

The Caswell County Board of Education prohibits unauthorized operation of recreational conveyances on all property of the Caswell County Schools. This prohibition shall not apply to any person operating any motor vehicle as a means of transportation to or from any regular session of the school and any school sponsored and supervised activity during non-school hours.

Any employee of the Caswell County Board of Education and any other person observing the operation of recreational conveyances on the property of the Caswell County Board of Education, contrary to the provisions of this policy or contrary to the laws of the State of North Carolina, should make a complaint known to the proper law enforcement officers of the County of Caswell.

The term "*recreational conveyances*" shall encompass mini-bikes, motorcycles, go-carts, ATV's, and other motorized vehicles, plus skateboards, roller blades, in-line skates, sleds, skis, and any other means of transportation that may result in damage to school property or endanger the health and well-being of the user.
