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To be entitled to initial entry in the Caswell County Public Schools, a child must have passed the fifth anniversary of his birth on or before **August 31st** of the year in which the child is presented for enrollment. The child should be presented for enrollment during the first month of the school year.

The initial point of entry with the Caswell County Public Schools shall be at the Kindergarten level. However, if a child has already been attending school in another state in accordance with the laws or regulations of the school authorities of such state before moving to and becoming a resident of Caswell County, the child will be eligible for enrollment in Caswell County Public Schools, regardless of whether the child has passed the fifth anniversary of his birth before **August 31st**.

The school Principal shall have the authority to require the parent/legal guardian/legal custodian of any child to furnish a certified copy of the child's birth certificate, if the child is presented for admission to the Caswell County Public Schools for the first time. Other documents needed to register a child are: an up-to-date immunization record, a health examination (may be completed within thirty (30) days of registration), a Social Security number, if one is available, and a power company bill for verification of home address. (The power bill requirement may be waived for migrant families only.)

NOTE: The birth certificate, immunization record, and power bill will be copied in the school office, with originals returned to the parent/legal guardian/legal custodian.
