

CASWELL COUNTY SCHOOLS BOARD OF EDUCATION POLICY	<u>STUDENTS</u> Foreign Exchange Students	415

Believing that educational and cultural exchange is of benefit to the students of Caswell County and to the community as a whole, the Caswell County Board of Public Education wholeheartedly endorses the enrollment of foreign students in the county high schools, under the following conditions:

1. The student is in the United States under a J-1 visa under the auspices of an educational exchange program endorsed by the Council on Standards for International Educational Travel of the U. S. Information Agency or the North Carolina International Exchange Network.
2. The student can demonstrate adequate proficiency in oral and written English to perform in classes without individual instruction.
3. The school is not expected to provide any monetary help of any type for the education or upkeep of the student.
4. Opportunities provided the exchange student do not cause denial of any opportunity to a Caswell County student.
5. No more than one student may be enrolled at any school from the same sponsoring agency without special approval of the Superintendent.
6. If, in the judgment of the Principal, enrollment of an exchange student would place undue hardship on the school's resources, admission may be denied.
7. To receive a diploma and participate in graduation exercises, an exchange student must fully document that he has met all Caswell County graduation requirements.
8. The student must live with a local family that has a child attending the subject school unless specifically approved by the Superintendent.
