Electronic Devices and Miscellaneous Items

Students who bring electronic devices and other non-essential items to school bring them at their own risk. The school will not be held responsible for items lost or stolen and will not spend valuable time investigating the loss.

Cell Phones, Beepers and Other Communication Devices:

Cell phones and beepers have become popular items for students to bring to school; however, they often cause disruptions to the school environment. Therefore, if these devices are brought to school, they must remain out of sight and be turned off between the hours of 7:45 and 3:05. The use of such items is prohibited at all times while on public school buses and activity buses unless there is an emergency.

Miscellaneous Items:

Radios, Tape Players, CD Players, Electronic Games, Laser Lights, Playing Cards, Dice and other non-essential items are not allowed on school property (including public school buses).

This rule does not apply to personal vehicles or overnight school sponsored field trips and athletic events.

Violations of this policy may result in consequences outlined in the Student Code of Conduct/School Handbook.
