Information Reports: Superintendent Reese presents the Georgia Court of Appeals Rule on Tenure in Charter Systems & Schools

Recently, there has been discussion about teacher tenure and the Fair Dismissal Act in charter schools and charter school systems. According to a Georgia Court of Appeals ruling (Day vs. Floyd), Georgia charter school systems and charter schools can waive the Fair Dismissal Act, unless the system's charter affirmatively incorporates the Fair Dismissal Act.

Superintendent Reese requested the Board's permission to "affirmatively state" in our charter application that Catoosa County Public Schools intends to continue to operate under the guidelines of the Fair Dismissal Act, which will protect teacher tenure and due process in our system. All Board members supported Mrs. Reese's request.
