Maintenance receives an additional .05 for holding wastewater and boiler licenses. Bus Mechanic receives an annual tool allowance of \$2,000. Bus Shop helper -

\$10.63/hr. Cafeteria managers in Elementary and High School Lunchroom are paid 1.20 times base Cafeteria salary. Certified Cafeteria managers in Elementary and High School will receive an additional \$500.00. District Treasurer receives an additional \$4000.00 for additional duties. Hourly contracted workers start at state minimum wage with no experience and \$.20 per year experience increments, up to 15 years. Non-contracted hourly will be paid state minimum wage. Lab Coordinator-weight of .065 for time in which certified teacher is not in classroom. Clerical, teacher's aides, and directors having an Associate Degree will receive an add'l \$3,000.00. Bus Drivers LENGTH OF ROUTE MULTIPLIERS - (1.00 up to 45 min. -- (1.05 from 45 to 55 min. -- (1.10) from 55 to 65 min. -- (1.15) from 65 to 75 min. -- (1.20 over 75 min. Multiplier will be based on the year just completed and will not change during the school year. Sub-drivers will be paid \$45.00/day. Trip drivers will be paid \$45.00 per trip and \$7.65/hr. X hours driven over 5 hours (minimum trip pay \$45.00). Add'l \$3,000 for Food Service Director for increased participation of the school lunch program and add'l duties in preparing school banquets.
