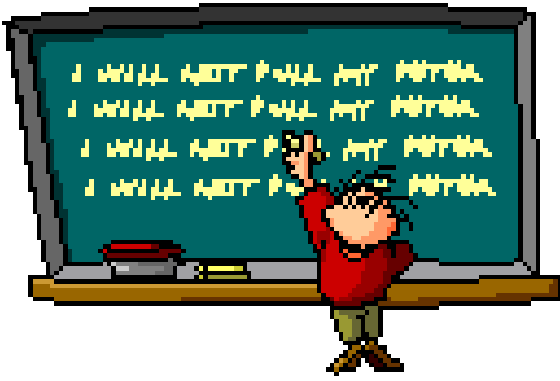

The Board of Education met at 7:00 p.m. on August 16, 2018, for their regular meeting at Central High School located in Camp Point.

President Moore asked if there were any questions and/or comments from the public. Hearing none, the meeting continued, and the current agenda was approved.

Committee Action Items

Building

- The building committee met on August 10th
- The parking lot at the high school has been resealed & painted over the summer. Also, lines for handicapped parking & fire lanes have been painted in the circle drive at the JH/CHS.
- The committee is looking in to putting a new culvert in the JH parking area in order to make another exit to help traffic flow.
- The steam line in the high school boy's restroom has been replaced over the summer.
- Air-conditioning is getting closer to completion in the high school. The Art and Ag classrooms are the two remaining rooms to be finished for this year.
- The junior high and high school phone system has been fixed. Shelly is getting estimates on replacing the system.
- All the lockers at the junior high and high school were painted over the summer.
- Thanks to the Boosters, a new approach to the football field was added over the summer.
