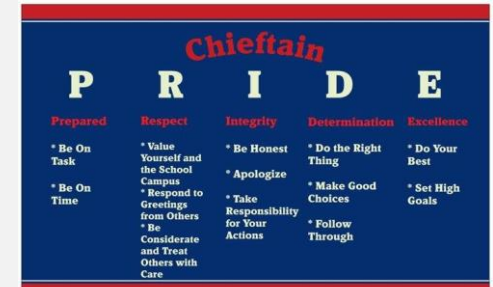

		<p>Hair: Natural hair color allowed. Any highlight or accent color deemed excessive by CCSS administration will not be permitted and will be considered a distraction to the classroom learning environment.</p>		
		<p>Females may wear any school-colored ribbon(s) or hairband. No headbands, caps, or bandanas allowed.</p>		
		<p>Males may not wear any kind of headbands or bandanas. Hair Ribbons must be solid colors of red, white, or blue. Only school logos on hair ribbons will be permitted. No headbands, caps, or bandanas allowed.</p>		
		<p>Jewelry: All students are allowed to wear earrings as long as they are not bigger than a quarter in diameter and length. No gauges allowed. Hoops/chains in facial piercings are not allowed. Excessive jewelry, beads, bangles, or piercings are open to administrative discretion. Earrings must NOT be bigger than a quarter in length or diameter.</p>		<p>SOCKS</p> <p>Socks should be worn at all times.</p>
