

Chilton County Schools Athletic Plan

In accordance with recent guidance from the Alabama Department of Public Health (ADPH), the Alabama State Department of Education (ALSDE), and the Alabama High School Athletic Association (AHSAA), Chilton County Schools athletic departments have developed a plan for attendance at all home athletic venues for fall of 2020. The plan is based on our effort to mitigate the risk of COVID-19. The current order from the ADPH states in paragraph 11. B. and C. that:

“Spectators are allowed to attend athletic events, but attendance at events will be significantly reduced as “spectators shall not congregate within 6 feet of a person from another household except to the extent necessary.” Furthermore, “spectators shall wear a mask or other facial covering that covers his or her nostrils and mouth at all times while within six feet of a person from another household.”

In order to comply with this order and allow for a safer environment, we will implement the following protocols for the fall 2020 athletic venues:

- Spectators will not be allowed entry to an athletic venue without a mask.
- All spectators will be required to wear a mask or facial covering at all times at any Chilton County Schools athletic event while within six feet of a person from another household.
- Spectators must not congregate within six feet of one another unless they live in the same household.
- Anyone who has come in contact with a person with COVID-19 or is currently quarantined should not attend any athletic event at Chilton County Schools.
- All visitors and spectators should screen and monitor themselves and family members for any signs of illness and stay home.

Chilton County Schools reserves the right to modify and strengthen these guidelines up to and including limiting number of tickets sold if these protocols are not followed.
