CERTAIN FAMILY MEMBERS ALLOWED TO VIEW GRADUATION

Pursuant to guidance issued by Governor Beshear, Christian County Public Schools is excited to announce that each graduate of the Class of 2020 may have up to four (4) family members (parents and/or legal guardians only) attend and watch as the graduate walks across the stage and receives his or her diploma, but the family members may only attend and watch their graduate walk and receive a diploma. Seniors and their family members must leave campus promptly upon the conclusion of the senior's time slot.

Upon arrival, seniors and their family members may not leave their car and enter the school building before the senior's scheduled time slot has arrived or before they have been instructed by school personnel to exit their vehicles and enter the school building. CCHS and HHS will be sending more particular guidance on designated entry points for guests.

Upon arrival, Seniors and each of their family members must be wearing a mask (masks will not be provided), sign a Covid-19 waiver, have their temperature taken by a healthcare professional, and apply hand sanitizer. While in the school building, seniors and their family members will be required to follow social distancing guidelines and wear a mask. Seniors and their family members must follow the instructions of all school personnel, law enforcement, and public health officials while on campus.

Seniors will only be allowed to remove their masks, momentarily, when their photograph is taken by school contracted personnel and they are being video recorded by school contracted personnel.

Family members will not be allowed to use flash photography or interrupt the commencement process in any way. After viewing, family members are expected to leave campus immediately. No photographs or gatherings of any kind will be permitted. Christian County administrators have the right to deny admittance to any guest per violation of CDC guidelines.
