BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, by the Common Council that Schedule II: Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours on Certain Streets shall now read as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 1596

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING SECTION 50.31
OF THE CODE OF ALEXANDRIA

WHEREAS, the Council deems it prudent and necessary to amend Section 50.31 as it relates to rates and charges of refuse and garbage removal.

NOW THERE, BE IT ORDAINED that Section 50.31 shall be amended to read as follows:

§ 50.31 COLLECTION FEES; LATE CHARGES.

- (A) Fees for refuse/garbage collection shall be as follows:
- (1) For each single-family dwelling or housing unit, the sum of Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) per month for weekly pick-up services of a single container not to exceed ninety-six (96) gallons.
 - (2) For a two or more family dwelling, the sum of Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) per month for weekly pick-up service of a single container not to exceed ninety-six (96) gallons. Should the residents desire additional containers, they must contract for the same with the third-party provider.
 - (3) Resident homeowners, occupants or tenants seventy (70) years and over, can qualify for reduced refuse/garbage collection rates. The reduced refuse/garbage collection rate shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for such eligible senior citizens. The collection shall be once a week of a thirty-two (32) gallon container (and not exceeding the container's capacity), placed on the curbside in front of the premises.
- (B) Service charges for flat rates, as specified in division (A) of this section, shall be added to the user's water, sewage, and sanitation charges and shall be payable as are bills for water, sewage, and sanitation service. Payments not made within fifteen (15) days of the billing date will have a late charge of Ten Percent (10%) for each month in which the payment remains delinquent. If any payment remains delinquent for more than three months, service will be discontinued. To reinstate service, all past due charges must be paid in full plus a reinstatement charge equal to one month's flat fee.

(C) If any service charge remains unpaid for a period of three (3) months, the charges may be certified to the Auditor of Madison County for placement upon the tax duplicate by the Auditor and collected as taxes are collected as provided in IC 18-5-10-77 (now repealed).

(D) Any request for rate change by the city shall be advertised not less than two times one week apart in no less than two county newspapers and shall state the date, time and location of a public meeting to advise the reasons for the rate change. In no event shall the fee schedule so established serve to collect monies in excess of those required for payment of costs incident to the services provided.

(E) All collection costs not covered herein will be reviewed on an individual basis.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that Section 50.17 of the Code of Alexandria is hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that Section 50.31(A)(1) herein shall be effective January 1, 2013.

ORDINANCE NO. 1581
AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING SECTION 130.02 OF THE
ALEXANDRIA CODE AND EXTENDING THE JURISDICTION OF THE
ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS BUREAU, SECTION 70.99(B)(3) AND (C)

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the City of Alexandria to make the following amendments to the Alexandria Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that Section 130.02 Interference with or Destroying City Property shall and the same is hereby amended to now read as follows:

SECTION 13.02 Interference with or Destroying City Property

It shall be unlawful for any person to intentionally, recklessly, or negligently interfere with, deface, damage, or destroy any City property.(penalty, see Section 10.99).

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that Section 70.99(B) (3) and (C) are hereby amended by the additions and modifications contained in the following paragraphs:
