Project Overview

At Coffee County School District, safety and comfort in the classroom is top priority. In an effort to modernize facilities, CCS partnered with Schneider Electric in 2014 to tackle necessary capital improvements on our 5 year plan. As a result, we received a complete wing renovation at New Brockton High School, new lighting in gyms, hallways, and classrooms, and mechanical renovations. On top of these improvements, the district has reduced operational costs and has positively impacted the environment.
