

The Coffee County School System earned a “B” (84) on the 2016-17 state report card. Our system’s report card grade is above the state score of a “C”. The “B” score ranks the system as one of the best county school systems in the state. We did not reach our goal of an “A” however; we are encouraged by the academic progress students are making. Our students, teachers, counselors, support personnel, and administrators have high standards and continue to work hard to achieve our goal of an “A.”

School data for this school year indicates that students are making significant gains in learning. The learning gains for this report card are 91.87% which is an “A.” Graduation rate on this report card is also an “A.”

The graduation rate and the college and career readiness rate that will be included on the 2017-18 report card have increased as follows:

- Graduation Rate has increased from 94% on the present report card to 98% on the 2017-18 report card.
- College and Career Readiness has risen from 77% on the present report card to 95% on the 2017-18 report card.
