The “Find A Book” website can help families identify books for their child that the child is interested in and is able to read. The website is located at www.lexile.com/findabook . The website uses a Lexile reading measure to determine appropriate books for the student. This Lexile measure can be found on your student’s Criterion Referenced Competency Test (CRCT) Report from your child’s school, or the *Find A Book* website can help you determine it. *(CRCT reports will be available at your child’s school around June 28.)*
