

Remote Learning Application 2020-2021

Coffee County Schools

Unlike the spring closure, the remote learning pathway will be aligned with direct classroom instruction aligned with curriculum standards. Students are accountable for daily participation, learning, and for the submission of assignments daily each of which is not optional. Grades and feedback will be given for assignments. Students will follow a defined schedule daily. Students in grades K-12 may be required to report to school for in person assessments, to be scheduled by the teacher. All required state testing must be completed on site and in person.

Parent Expectations and Requirements

I understand the following:

- By completing this application, I am expressing my desire for my child(ren) to receive their education entirely via online learning.
- I must provide internet connectivity to a Chromebook for students in grades 3-12. For K-2, parents must be able to access the internet to interact with teachers (computer, Smartphone, tablet).
- I am committing to one full quarter (nine weeks) of remote learning for my student(s).
- I will need to complete a new application each quarter.
- Students are expected to be present daily while utilizing remote learning.
- Students in grades K-5 must have an adult in the home to assist with online learning daily.
- Students in grades 6-12 will follow the daily schedule of classes for online learning and are required to be present for all classes during remote learning.
- The district will be using software for monitoring and recording student participation as well as evidence of attendance.
- Students are not allowed to enter the building during school hours without administrative permission.
- Certain courses may not be available through distance learning.
- School counselors will evaluate schedules and make changes as needed.
- For instructional reasons and to support student learning needs, learning appointments will be required for the purpose of conducting on site screenings.
- In the event of technical difficulties, the parent or student should notify the teacher via email and the teacher will contact the District IT Dept.
- Parents/Guardians are responsible for creating a stable remote learning environment, including internet connectivity when appropriate; otherwise, my student(s) may be required to return to the building while school is open.
- A lack of participation in remote learning will result in unexcused absences and will result in the student being placed immediately on the tiered attendance intervention program outlined by Board Policy 6.200.
- The district is providing my child(ren) in grades 3-12 with a Chromebook. I am completely responsible for any and all damage to the Chromebook and assume full financial responsibility of the device. Further, all learning activities must occur on the district Chromebook.
- My ParentVUE account allows for messaging between parents and teachers.
