Tops: Students have a choice of a collared shirt in white, navy, light blue, light pink, grey, and light yellow or a school sponsored t-shirt.

Bottoms: Students have a choice of pants, skirts, skorts, jumpers, capri length pants, and denim jeans that are khaki, black or navy in color.



New guidelines for all grade levels:

- Denim jeans should not have holes or rips in the garment.



- Shirts do not have to be tucked in.
- School where the student attends sponsored t-shirts are approved.
- Exemptions for religious beliefs or medical reasons can be submitted to the school principal.

New guidelines for grades 6-12:

- Student ID badges must be worn.
