## **PARENTAL RIGHTS NOTIFICATION**

The Corinth School District is required to notify parents that they have the right to receive information on the following:

- Whether the teacher has met state qualifying and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher is teaching;
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which state qualification or licensing criteria have been waived;
- The baccalaureate degree major of the teacher and any other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher, including the field of discipline of the certification or degree; and
- Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications. Corinth School District requires all paraprofessionals to meet the NCLB definition of highly qualified prior to being recommended for employment.

In addition, Corinth School District is required to notify parents when their child is assigned or taught by a teacher who is not highly qualified for four or more consecutive weeks.

Each school will notify parents by letter when this situation exists.
