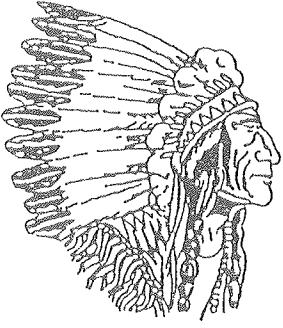

Amount of Unpaid Lunch Charges last year

Parents and Guardians,

We have been sending home letters via US mail and with your students to keep you informed of your student's outstanding lunch charges. We have also begun making phone calls in an effort to work with you to get the charges down to a minimum. However, these methods are not working and there is currently \$6,800 owed to the school district for the first six months of this year.

Therefore, the district will begin to serve an alternate lunch in **January** for students who owe a **balance of \$25 or greater**.

An alternate lunch includes a cheese sandwich, an apple, and a milk.

If you would like to make sure your child continues to receive the school hot lunch he/she is used to eating, please make sure their account does not have a balance greater than \$25.

You may send money to school with your child, through the US Mail to Cottonwood Union School District, ATTN: Food Service, 20512 W. First Street, Cottonwood, CA 96022, or utilize the www.myschoolbucks.com website. You may pay in advance on your account if you wish, in fact, **we encourage you to do so.**
